

REACH Compliance Statement

August 29, 2017

Matrox Electronic Systems' products have been assessed against Regulation (EC) 1907/2006 of the European Parliament (REACH) and are defined as articles as per Article 3.3.

Articles that do not intentionally release substances have no pre-registration or registration requirements. Matrox Electronic Systems' products do not intentionally release substances and, therefore, have no pre-registration or registration requirements.

Recipients of articles containing Candidate Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC's) above 0.1 % w/w must be given sufficient information to ensure safe use of the product as per REACH article 33.1.

Notification to the ECHA of the presence of Candidate SVHCs in articles will be required beginning December, 2010 under REACH Article 7.2 if:

- (a) the substance is present in those articles in quantities totalling over 1 tonne per producer or importer per year;*
- (b) the substance is present in those articles above a concentration of 0,1 % weight by weight (w/w).*

As of June 16, 2017, the SVHC Candidate List establishes 174 Substances as SVHC's. This list can be found, with detailed information, on the ECHA website (<http://echa.europa.eu/web/guest/candidate-list-table>). 43 of these substances are included in the Authorization List. Substances on this list are subject to authorization requirements.

Matrox Electronic Systems will fulfill the notification, communication and authorization requirements if and when any SVHC's are detected in our products above 0.1 % w/w.
